

Public Hearing  
June 25, 2019

The Colfax County Board of Commissioners met on this date in a Public Hearing in the Commission Chambers with the following members present:

Also present were: Mary Lou Kern, County Manager and Rayetta M. Trujillo, County Clerk.

Chairman LeDoux called the Public Hearing to order at 10:00 a.m. The purpose of the Public Hearing was for Discussion of ICIP for FY 2019/2020.


Discussion during the Public Hearing included:

County Manager Kern stated the Public Hearings are held for suggestions on infrastructure. She stated all admissions or omissions will be considered for an increase or elimination of projects. County Manager Kern stated the Sheriff's vehicles were removed last year but will be reapplied for within a few years. She stated the County requested an increase in funds for equipment for the Road Department and funding for a Dispatch Center for the County. She stated Gardener Bridge may receive potential funding but if the funding is not granted then it will be incorporated into the ICIP Plan. Chairman LeDoux stated the Commission submits a 5-year plan but County Manager Kern updated the plan. He stated suggestions for an increase or elimination of projects before the ICIP is adopted. County Treasurer Kathy M. Trujillo suggested a project for a facility where County records can be archived that is owned by the County. County Manager Kern stated there is a request in for the year 2023 but it can be reallocated for a more recent project. County Treasurer Trujillo stated Santa Fe does not have adequate space to store the County's records. County Clerk Trujillo stated all her records are on microfiche, scanned in, and the office also keeps hard copies in the books. Commissioner Newton stated the requested funds should be continued for Road Department equipment, Sheriff and County vehicles, computers and computer software, Blosser Gap Bridge, and for Gardener Bridge. He stated leaks were detected in the Assessors Office and there is need for an animal shelter within the County. Chairman LeDoux stated the County should consider increasing the amount requested for projects.


Chairman LeDoux asked if there were any comments but none were raised. The Public Hearing adjourned at 10:06 a.m.
