The Colfax County Board of Commissioners met on this date in a Special Session in the Commission Chambers with the following members present:

1. Call to Order

Chairman LeDoux called the meeting to order at 11:00 a.m.

Commissioner Newton led the Salute to the New Mexico Flag.

4. Approved Agenda

Chairman LeDoux stated the Commission received the Agenda prior to Canvass the February 5th Maxwell School District all Mail Election Results and asked if anyone had any comments. There were none raised. Commissioner Fernandez made a motion to approve the Agenda as presented. Commissioner Newton seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

6. Discuss/Action – Canvass February 5, 2019 Maxwell School District all Mail Election Results

County Clerk Rayetta M. Trujillo stated this meeting was to canvass the All Mail Election that was held on February 5, 2019. She stated 280 ballots were mailed to registered voters within the appropriate precincts. County Clerk Trujillo stated 113 voted ballots were received, 29 were received undeliverable, and 138 with no response. She stated out of the 113 votes the Precinct Board reviewed; one envelope was not signed, and one had a signed envelope, but the ballot was not in the envelope. County Clerk Trujillo stated 111 ballots were processed through the voting machine of which 90 in favor and 21 against. There was discussion over the SB9 for the continued funding of structural maintenance for the school. Commissioner Newton made a motion to approve the Canvass February 5, 2019 Maxwell School District all Main Election as presented. Commissioner Fernandez seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.
