

Public Hearing  
February 25, 2019

The Colfax County Board of Commissioners met on this date in a Public Hearing in the Commission Chambers with the following members present:

Bobby LeDoux, Chairman  
Landon Newton, Vice-Chairman  
Roy Fernandez, Member

Also present were: Mary Lou Kern, County Manager, Rayetta M. Trujillo, County Clerk and Terrence Kamm, County Attorney.

Chairman LeDoux called the Public Hearing to order at 12:40 p.m. The purpose of the Public Hearing was for discussion of the Solid Waste Ordinance #2015-04.

Others in attendance were: Sara Torres, Amanda Segura, Joana Apodaca, Suzie Valdez, and Kathee Adams.

Discussion during the Public Hearing included:

County Manager Kern stated the proposed change is to Section 9B of the present ordinance and is as follows:

“Yard refuse limited to grass, pine needles, leaves and cut weeds may be placed in county roadside solid waste containers. All other yard refuse, including without limitations, tree branches, shall not be placed in county roadside solid waste containers and shall be disposed of on the site on which it is generated or in an approved solid waste facility, or in accordance with any applicable county, state or federal laws or regulations, at the expense of the person accumulating such waste.”

There was discussion over the proposed change. Commissioner Fernandez made a motion to introduce an amendment to the current Solid Waste Ordinance #2015-04. Commissioner Newton seconded the motion. Chairman LeDoux asked for a roll call vote, the Clerk Rayetta Trujillo polled the Commissioners. Chairman LeDoux – aye, Commissioner Newton – aye, and Commissioner Fernandez – aye. The motion carried unanimously.

The Public Hearing adjourned at 12:44 p.m.
