The Colfax County Board of Commissioners met on this date in a Special Session in the Commission Chambers with the following members present:

1. Call to Order

Chairman Sauble called the meeting to order at 11:00 a.m.

2. Pledge of Allegiance

Commissioner Fernandez led the Pledge of Allegiance.

3. Salute to the New Mexico Flag

Chairman Sauble led the Salute to the New Mexico Flag.

4. Approve Agenda

Commissioner Fernandez made a motion to approve the agenda. Chairman Sauble seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

5. Recognize Visitors

6. Discuss/Action Canvass June 5, 2018 Primary Election Results

Chairman Sauble stated the reason for the Special Meeting is for Canvassing June 5, 2018 Primary Election Results. County Clerk Rayetta congratulated all Candidates who ran in the Election. She stated the Provisional Ballots were verified as eligible voters, did not previously vote, and will be presented to the Board for approval. County Clerk Rayetta stated there were Fourteen Provisional Ballots received, which she recommended twelve of them be counted. She requested two of the Provisional Ballots be rejected due to the voters not being registered under any of the Three Major Political Parties which were the only Parties Eligible to vote in the Primary Election.

The Commission tallied the twelve Provisional Ballots and Canvassed by Precinct in the 2018 Primary Election and the results are as follows.

The total votes cast in Colfax County were 2,140. The Democratic Party cast 1,552 votes, the Libertarian Party cast 1 vote, and the Republican Party cast 587 votes.

Commissioner Fernandez made a motion to accept the Canvass Results as reported and reviewed for the Primary Election of June 5, 2018, and to send a copy of the Canvass to the Secretary of State. Candidate Certificate of Nomination Elects should be issue to County Candidates 31 days after the Canvass. Chairman Sauble Seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.
