**ORDINANCE NO. 2005- 2
AMENDING ORDINANCE 2005-1
SPECIFIC EXEMPTIONS OF COLFAX
COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION EXCISE TAX**

NOTICE is hereby given that the Board of Commissioners of Colfax County, New Mexico intends to adopt an ordinance amending Colfax County Ordinance No. 2005-1, which ordinance shall be know as Ordinance No. 2005-2 Amending Ordinance 2005-1 Specific Exemptions of Colfax County Fire Protection Excise Tax.

SUMMARY: An ordinance amending Section 3 of Colfax County Ordinance No. 2005-1 as follows:

Section 3. Specific Exemptions. No county fire protection excise tax shall be imposed on the gross receipts arising from:

- A. transporting persons or property for hire by railroad, motor vehicle, air transportation or any other means from one point within the county to another point outside the county; or
- B. direct broadcast satellite services.

Ordinance 2005-1 effective July 1, 2005 shall in all other respects remain in full force and effect, except as expressly amended by the proposed ordinance.

Notice of the proposed ordinance shall be published in the manner provided by law and shall be considered for adoption in open meeting by the Board of Commissioners of Colfax County, New Mexico at its meeting to be held MAY 10, 2005.

**ORDINANCE NUMBER 2005-2
AMENDING SPECIFIC EXEMPTIONS OF
COLFAX COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION EXCISE TAX ORDINANCE**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF COLFAX COUNTY, NEW MEXICO that Section 3 of Ordinance 2005-01, effective July 1, 2005, and imposing one-quarter of one per cent (.25%) of the gross receipts tax is amended to read:

Section 3. Specific Exemptions. No county fire protection excise tax shall be imposed on the gross receipts arising from:

- A. transporting persons or property for hire by railroad, motor vehicle, air transportation or any other means from one point within the county to another point outside the county; or
- B. direct broadcast satellite services.
