

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RATON, NO. 564, RELATING
TO THE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN PROPERTY CONTIGUOUS TO THE
NORTHEAST BOUNDARY LINE OF THE PRESENT CITY LIMITS OF

RATON

WHEREAS:

1. There has been presented to the City Commission of the City of Raton a Petition executed by a majority of the owners of certain property lying to the Northeast of the present and existing city limit line of Raton, Colfax County, New Mexico, requesting that said property and real estate be annexed to, and become a part of, the City of Raton, for all municipal purposes and benefits; and
2. There is attached to and filed with said Petition a plat representing a survey and plat of the territory sought to be annexed and the acreage contained therein; and
3. The said tract of land described in said Petition is contiguous to the present city limit line of the City of Raton; and
4. It is the opinion of the City Commission after recommendation of annexation by the City Planning Commission, that said Petition and plat are in the proper form and in conformity with the laws of the State of New Mexico, and that it would be for the best interests of the City of Raton if said contiguous territory be incorporated and annexed to the City of Raton and become a part thereof;

NOW THEREFORE; BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF RATON:

1. That the following described real estate be, and the same hereby is, annexed to the City of Raton, to-wit:

A part of the West half of the East half of the Southeast quarter (W $\frac{1}{2}$ E $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Eighteen (18), Township Thirty-one (31) North, Range Twenty-four (24) East, R.M.P.M., Colfax County, New Mexico, more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point whence the quarter corner for Sections Nineteen (19) and Twenty-four (24), Township Thirty-one (31) North, Range Twenty-four (24) East, R.M.P.M., bears South 2,693.2 feet and bears West 2,052.6 feet distant;

Thence North 2,173.19 feet;
thence South 58° 34' West 1,084.67 feet;

thence South 0° 45' East 1,428.79 feet; thence North 88° 05' East 208.71 feet; thence South 0° 45' East 208.71 feet; thence North 88° 05' East 695.83 feet to the point of beginning.

- 2. That all of the above described real estate, now a part of the municipality, shall be forthwith included within and made a part of the City of Raton for all purposes, and the corporate limits of the City of Raton be, and the same hereby are, changed and extended so as to include the said real estate.
- 3. That all of the laws of the State of New Mexico applicable to the City of Raton, and all of the ordinances, resolutions, rules and regulations now and hereafter in effect within the City of Raton shall, after the date of adoption of this Ordinance and its recordation as provided by law, be in full force and effect throughout all of the above described property.
- 4. That a certified copy of this Ordinance, pursuant to law, shall be filed with the County Clerk of Colfax County, New Mexico.

The foregoing Ordinance was adopted at a regular meeting of the City Commission of the City of Raton, on the 14th day of April, 1966, and upon examination duly approved by me as Mayor of the said City, and attested by the Clerk thereof on said date.
