The State of New Mexico requires all livestock to be reported to the County Assessors Office. Livestock that is in New Mexico for a portion of a tax year exceeding twenty days are subject to Ad valorem tax at a pro-rated value. Subsection D of Sec. 7-36-21 NMSA

7-36-21 NMSA – Any person who intentionally refuses to make a report required of him under this section or who knowingly makes a false statement in a report required under this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by the imposition of a fine of not more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000).

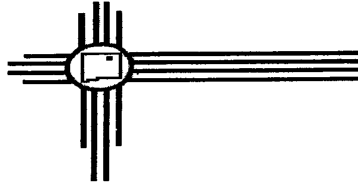

Dear Livestock Owner;

Our records indicate that you have or have had livestock located in Colfax County. Please complete and return the livestock rendition form on the reverse side of this letter within 10 days after receiving this letter. **This report shall contain all livestock located in Colfax County for the 2008 tax year. NM Statute 7-36-21 places the duty to report on the owner of the livestock. Any person who intentionally refuses to make a report or a false statement is guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by the imposition of a fine of not more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000).**

Should any livestock be moved in or out of the county during the year, this office shall be notified immediately at which time we will pro-rate them for the time they were in the county. If you fail to do so our office will assume that the livestock have resided within the county for the remainder of the year.

Livestock rendition report shall include how many of each class of livestock and how long they will reside within the county. **In the event that you have livestock in multiple school districts a separate report should be filed for each school district.** In the event that you have no livestock you still need to return the form to our office reporting the zero (0) count. If you fail to return the form the livestock counts that were on for the prior year will be rolled over for the current year.

If you have any questions concerning the rendition of your livestock or if you wish to request additional forms, please contact our office and ask for Rebecca. We will be glad to assist you.
