

SPECIAL MEETING

June 10, 2016

The Colfax County Board of Commissioners met on this day in Special Session in the Commission Chambers with the following members present:

1. Call to Order

Chairman Sauble called the meeting to order at 10:03 am.

2. Pledge of Allegiance

County Clerk Rebecca Hoy led the Pledge of Allegiance.

3. Salute to the New Mexico Flag

Commissioner Sauble led the Salute to the New Mexico Flag.

4. Approve Agenda

Commissioner Fernandez made a motion to approve the agenda. Commissioner Newton seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

5. Recognize Visitors

6. Discuss/Action – Canvass June 7, 2016 Primary Election Results

Chairman Sauble turned the meeting over to Rebecca Hoy, County Clerk. She mentioned each had several reports in front of them along with each precinct's machine tapes and roster covers for them to review. Rebecca stated that the Election ran smoothly, both during the day and in the evening with the tabulations. There were a couple of machine malfunctions, but her precinct workers handled the situation correctly, and they were resolved in a short time frame. The Election had 5 Provisional Ballots, 3 Democrats and 2 Republicans, which were opened June 8 due to a District Court Order since the District Attorney's race was so close. Rebecca explained the situation with each Provisional Ballot and recommended they accept 3, 2 Democrats and 1- Republican and reject 2, 1-Democrat and 1-Republican ballots.

Commissioner Newton made a motion to accept 4 Provisional Ballots, 3-Democrats and 1-Republican, and reject 1-Republican. Commissioner Fernandez seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

After tallying the 4 Provisional Ballots and canvassed by precinct the 2016 Primary Election results are as follow:
